Northwest Cancer Research – Lab Coat Learning Workshops

We have arranged for NWCR to visit school to run some workshops for the children. NWCR run these workshops free of charge, however, we will be holding a non-uniform day to raise vital funds for the charity.

Due to PE lessons early in the week, the non-uniform day will be held on the Thursday (15th February), so please send in a cash donation on Thursday only. Donations can be handed to the class teacher or any member of staff.

Tuesday 13th February – Reception, Years 1, 2 & 3

Using their mini mascot, Hope Bear, the workshop will discuss the importance of a healthy diet. The workshop will encourage the children to highlight what they think being healthy means and will be focused on a teddy bear's picnic. The children will then create their own healthy eating plate to take away with them.

Thursday 15th February – Years 4, 5 & 6
