For all clubs, please collect as normal via the front loop at 4.30pm. Any siblings in Night Owls will be brought to the front loop as usual.

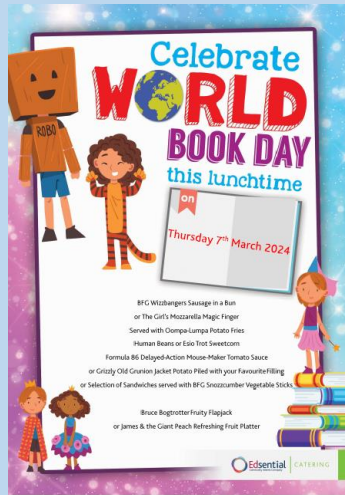

T-Shirt Designs

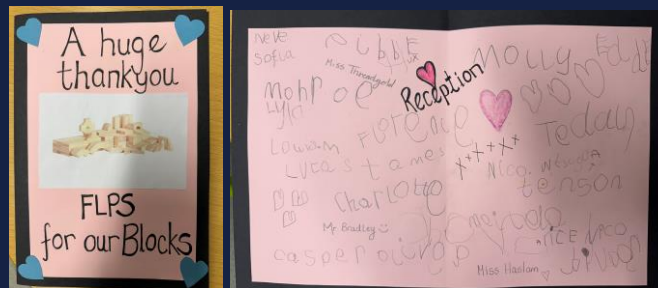
Hopefully, the creation of your white t-shirts is going well! A reminder for the children to wear them as part of the non-uniform day next Thursday.

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Snap Trap – Thursday 14th March – Year 6 pupils & parents

A reminder to Year 6 parents that on the 14th of March we will be having theatre group come into school to discuss online safety to the children. Parents are welcome to attend. The start time is 9.30am and will last for approximately 1 hour.

'The Snap Trap' is a theatre-based session aimed at children in years 5 & 6. It helps them recognise the risks associated with online activity, social media applications and smart devices. The session stages the stories of young people whose lives were affected by online bullying, social media misuse and online grooming.
